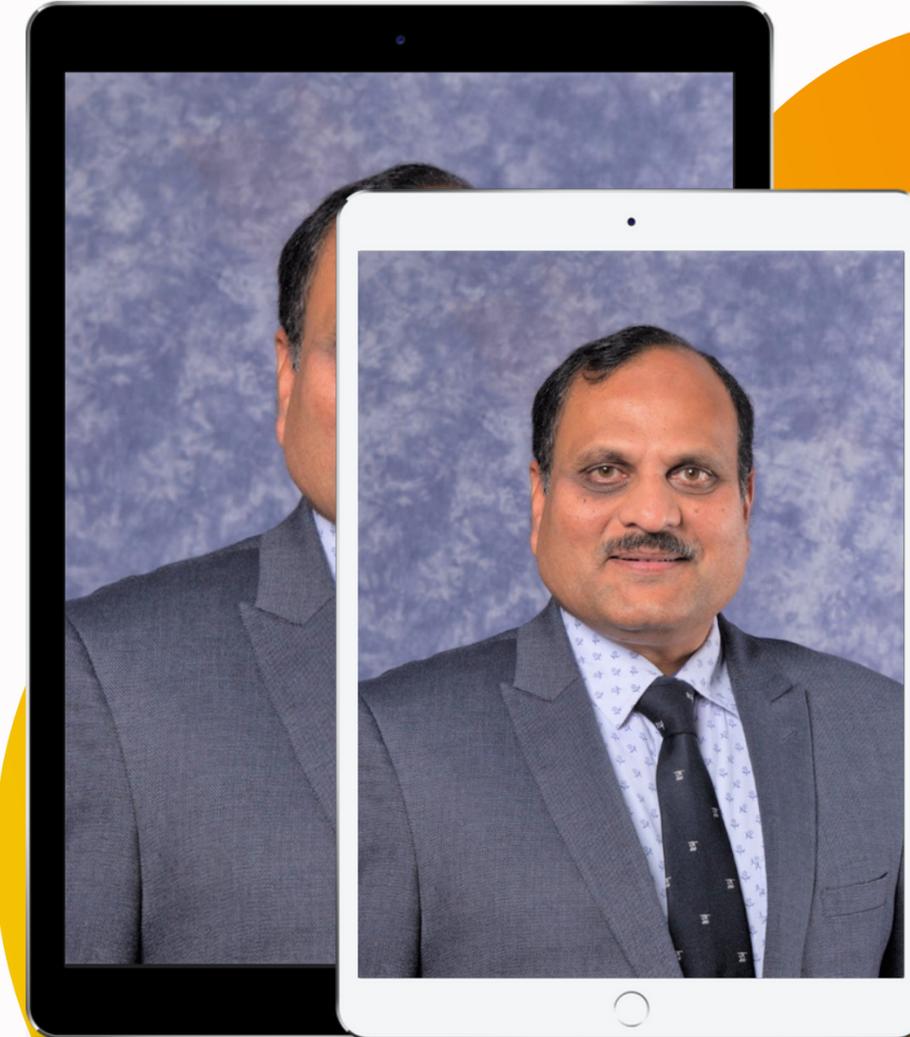

Wishing you all very prosperous and successful years ahead.

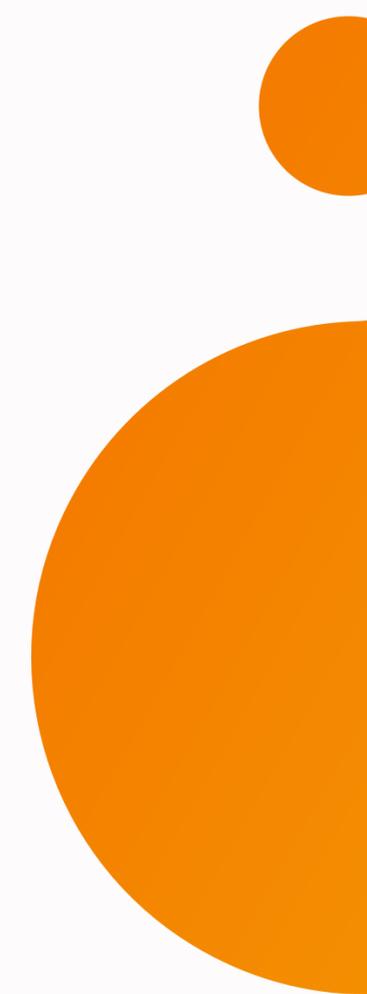
